

# Current Safe Havens

Safe havens— Areas approved by local or state authorities for the parking of unattended vehicles containing Division 1.1, 1.2 or 1.3 (Class A or Class B) explosive materials.

The following is a list a current Safe havens (as of March 1, 2016) by State;

**Alabama** - The following safe haven has been approved by local government (City of Lincoln) and evaluated/recognized by the Alabama Department of Public Safety.

- **Tri-State Motor Transit**  
From I-20 take the Talledega/Lincoln exit 168.  
Go 2.9 miles north on Alabama 77, turn right on gravel road.  
Lincoln, Alabama.



**Nebraska** - The following safe haven has been approved by local authorities.

- **Tomahawk Oil Company LTD**  
Interstate 80, Exit 164  
Hershey, Nebraska



**Pennsylvania** - The following safe havens have been approved by local governments.

- **Pocono Auto and Truck Plaza**  
Interstate 80 and U.S. 611, Exit 46 North  
Bartonsville, Pennsylvania
- **Clearfield Truckstop**  
Interstate 80, Exit 19  
Clearfield, Pennsylvania



**Tennessee** - Local government agencies have found that the following safe havens meet the requirements set forth in 49 CFR Section 397.7. They have also been approved (in writing) by their local Sheriff Departments, giving them permission to be designated as safe havens.

- **Truckers Terminal Truck Stop**  
Interstate-81, Exit 4 and  
White Pine Road White Pine, Tennessee
- **Truckstops of America**  
Interstate-40/Interstate-75, Exit 374  
Concord, Tennessee



States not listed above **DO NOT** offer Safe havens at this time. This includes the District of Columbia. If in doubt contact the Hazardous Materials section of the state in question.
